UV Light Directions for Use:

1. Press and hold the button on the green cap to turn on the UV light
2. Run the light down the bill to expose the hidden security stripe
3. Use the security stripe guide to identify the correct color and location

Detector Pen Directions for Use:

1. Uncap marker
2. Draw a straight line on the suspicious bill
3. A light-yellow line will appear for real bills, a dark line will appear for fakes

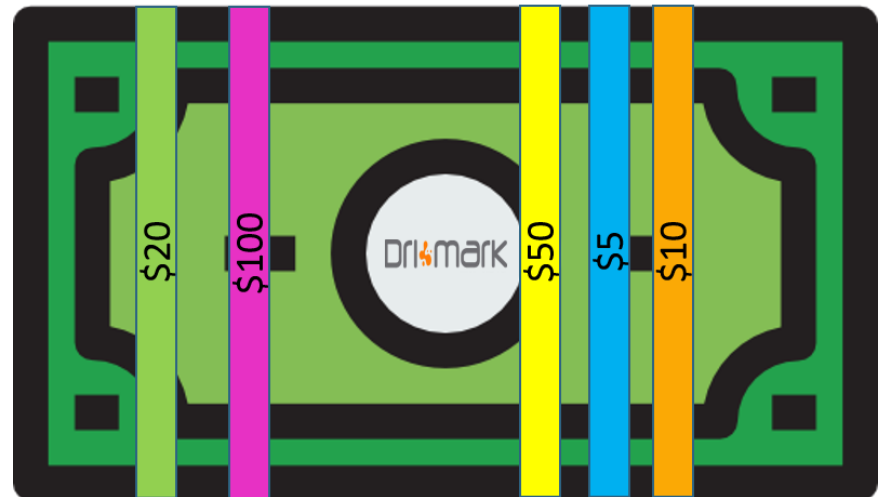


Ink Guide:

1. Draw a prominent line on the suspicious bill
2. A light-yellow line will appear on legitimate currency and eventually disappear after time
3. A dark mark will appear and stay on fake bills
